Music Theory Classes

Christian Greetings to you! As the Barbados SDA Secondary School seeks to strengthen its fledgling music department, we would like to inform you of the music theory classes that we are planning to offer in the coming year. The music theory classes, which will be conducted by Dr. Eldon Blackman, the Music teacher and Choral Director, will be geared toward preparing students for the

graded examinations of the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music, in England. In these initial stages we are planning to offer music theory classes from grade 1 through to grade 5, however, the classes that will be



offered will be based on demand.

Classes will begin on **Tuesday, February 7th, 2017 at 3:30om, for one hour**. The Tuesday class sessions will focus on grades 1-3 and, depending on the demand for higher grades, we will consider scheduling an additional day. All students will be required to purchase, and bring to class, the appropriate workbook for their particular grade as well as the prescribed text for the course.

The cost for grades 1-3 will be \$60 per month, and \$75 for grades 4-5. All fees should be paid at the school's business office no later than **January 31st, 2017**.

Please note that students of the secondary school will not be required to pay for these classes. The cost for students from the Bridgetown SDA Primary School will be 50% of the regular cost.

Registration forms can be collected from and returned to the

school's business office or to the Principal's Secretary at the secondary school. A limited amount of forms will also be available from your church's Education Secretary.
